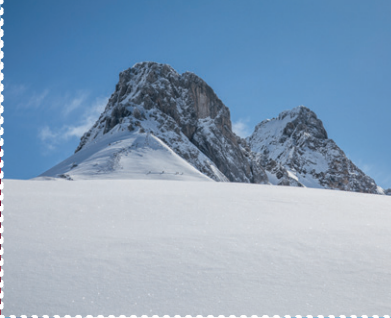

WELCOME!

Welcome to Warth-Schröcken! Our region incorporates two small mountain villages situated at an altitude of 1,200 to 1,500 metres which together only have 400 inhabitants. Even 700 years after the settlement of the Walsers (the people from this Alpine region) from the Swiss canton of Wallis, you can still feel the Walser charm here. Warth-Schröcken has remained traditional and modest yet modern enough to guarantee exciting fun and variety in all areas of your holiday.

Until the early 20th century, the Walsers, also often referred to as the pioneers of the Alps, lived solely from farming which involved very hard work. Tourism began to develop in the 1930s and this was followed by the building of the first ski lifts in the 1960s.

In the winter you will find a snow-covered paradise in Warth-Schröcken. Thanks to its special geographic location, there is an above average amount of snowfall here, which makes the area one of the regions in Europe with the most snow and the highest certainty of snow. Our side of the Arlberg therefore promises a true el dorado with many great possibilities for deep snow lovers and freeriders as well as cross country skiers and hikers.

This brochure offers you lots of useful information and tips to make your holiday in Warth-Schröcken as enjoyable and varied as possible. We are also available in person to offer help and advice in our local tourist offices.

WARTH-SCHRÖCKEN

Two former small mountain farming villages with Walser charm in the heart of a cosmopolitan ski area.

SKIING HISTORY

The skiing history of Warth-Schröcken already began back in the 19th century, when Warth's Pastor Johann Müller was the first to master the route from Warth to Lech and back again on skis in terrain covered in deep snow. He is proudly regarded as one of the first ski pioneers in Arlberg.*

THE DIFFICULT EARLY DAYS.

The Walser folk, who settled the Tannberg region (Warth, Schröcken & Lech) in the 14th century, chose a bleak and harsh life as mountain farmers. They lived exclusively off of dairy farming and livestock until the start of the 20th century. A well-developed access road was inconceivable at the time. In those times, the sites were only accessible by mule tracks or cart paths. These places were sometimes cut off from each other and from the surrounding valley communities for weeks at a time - especially during the rough winters.



THE BEGINNINGS OF WINTER TOURISM.

Indeed, one could say that the start of winter tourism was thanks to the steady increase of guests during the summer months.

And so it came to pass that in addition to the "Zum Ochsen" Inn that was already there (today the "Tannberg" Inn in Schröcken), the "Widderstein" Inn also opened at the start of the 1900s. In Warth, guests found lodgings in the rectory as well as in the "Tirolerhof" and "Adler" Inn. The construction of the "Biberkopf" Hotel, which opened in 1928, set new standards, as the installation of central heating enabled the comfortable accommodation of winter guests for the first time.



THE FIRST SKI SCHOOLS & SKI LIFTS.

Another milestone in the development of tourism in Warth-Schröcken was the founding of the first ski schools. In 1926, the Warth Ski School was founded by Otto Fritz, and in 1936, the Schröcken-Körbersee Ski School (today the Snowsports School Schröcken) was founded by Fritz Stolz. Tourism in Warth-Schröcken almost came to a complete standstill during the Second World War and with the establishment of the 1,000 Mark Blockade. Outside traffic returned and flourished only after years, and the infrastructure was invested in once again. So it came to pass that in 1954, the first ski lifts were set-up in Warth, and further lift access was developed in the years that followed. 1963, the year when the Warth ski lifts were opened and the founding of the Ski Lift Society, construction began on the Saloberkopf and Sonnenkopf lift systems.

MILESTONES IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE SKI AREA.

At the end of the 1970s, the connection from Warth to Schröcken was attained and the resulting "Warth-Salober" ski area has become the third-largest ski area in Vorarlberg. The most important milestone to date in the skiing history of Warth-Schröcken was achieved in the winter of 2013/14: After 41 long years of discussion, the connection on the Arlberg was made with the Auenfeldjet. In winter 2016/17, the last missing area was developed on Arlberg with the new Flexenbahn cable way, with which ambitious skiers can reach all the spots on Arlberg on skis in just one day. In December 2017, the Warth village metro became operational, connecting the village centre with the ski resort.



WARTH-SCHRÖCKEN TODAY.

The historical and tourism development with all its achieved milestones allows Warth-Schröcken to present itself today as a modern and sporty ski resort. It is not only one of the largest connected ski resorts in Austria in the "Ski Arlberg" network, but also one of the five largest worldwide. With 305 kilometres of ski runs, 200 kilometres of deep snow, and 88 lifts and cable ways, a new dimension of winter sport enjoyment presents itself in Arlberg to the ambitious skier.

WALSER VILLAGE WARTH



Warth am Arlberg – a panoramic, high-altitude village with endless charm.

The village of Warth is idyllically situated at an altitude of 1,500 metres in the heart of an impressive mountain scenery which the Walsers chose as a place in which to settle already in the 14th century.

As early as 1894, a man from Warth became the talk of the area with his pioneering achievement – vicar Johann Müller was the first person to travel by skis here. The large amount of snow led this man of God to having the idea of using long wooden slats, which he had ordered from Sweden, for his visits to the neighbouring village of Lech. Further skiing greats emerged in the following years. Wiltrud Drexel, for example, won Bronze in the giant slalom in the 1972 Olympics and Hubert Strolz won Olympic Gold in the combination in Calgary.

The construction of the first ski lifts in the mid-1960s and the development of the federal highways also led to a continuous development in tourism here which continues to the present day. Yet despite the extensive development, the Walser village character of this former mountain farming village still remains.

Together with Hochkrumbach, 165 residents now live here throughout the whole year. The top hotels with one 3***, four 4**** and three 4****s are mainly family businesses which are now being managed in the second and third generations.



WALSER VILLAGE SCHRÖCKEN



Schröcken – expansive high-altitude settlement in a spectacular mountain setting in typical Walser style.

Schröcken's landscape is characterised as being exceptionally varied whereby the area exhibits the typical character of a Walser community with very scattered hamlets and farms.

The name Schröcken also derives from the rugged mountain landscape here although until 1640 it was known as “Giersboden” after the Walser term “Gir” meaning “bird of prey”.

A further pioneering achievement which occurred here was by Alfons Strolz who built the first T-bar lift in Schröcken on his own in 1953. In 1964 he founded Skilifte Schröcken. The development of the Hochtannbergstrasse road in 1954 was a further milestone in the development of tourism.

Today, 220 residents live in this small community throughout the whole year, most of whom are represented in one of the many community associations. The Streusiedlung (scattered settlement) which is divided into nine land lots (= districts) in Schröcken, is typical of a Walser community. Situated on slopes and plateaus, the community is divided between the lowest district of Unterboden with 1,150 metres up to the natural gem of the Körbersee lake at an altitude of 1,660 m.

The accommodation in Schröcken ranges from cosy and comfortable holiday apartments and B&Bs to hotels with half-board and exclusively furnished chalets.



SKI REGION

The Warth-Schröcken ski region is, together with Ski Arlberg, the biggest in Austria.



WARTH-SCHRÖCKEN

GUARANTEED SNOW ON THE ARLBERG.

The Warth-Schröcken ski area lies at an altitude between 1,500 and 2,050 metres, nestled between the Bregenzerwald, the Lechtaler and Allgäu Alps and the Arlberg region.

This geographical setting as a natural barrier to the North-West guarantees an above-average amount of fresh snow winter after winter, making the region one of the snowiest in Europe. Warth-Schröcken is particularly popular with those who enjoy spring skiing and on the northern slopes you can also find excellent pistes in the afternoons during the warm weather.

MOTHER HOLLE'S EARTHLY COLLEAGUE.

Over just two summers, one of the most modern snow-making machines in the Alps has been created at an altitude of 2,000 metres. Special attention was given to embedding it into the alpine nature. 104 snowing devices, 19 lances and 85 propellers ensure perfect winter sports fun. In combination with the natural snow - of which there is a great deal of with a snow guarantee - the system ensures optimal slope conditions from the first day of skiing to the last.



FAMILY-FRIENDLY.

A host of adventure spots for young and old provide for variety on the piste. Whether at photo points, fun slopes or speed checks, in Warth-Schröcken fun on the slopes is guaranteed. You will find all the adventure offers on the piste on page 48.

Ski Arlberg: largest interlinked ski area in Austria with 305 kilometres of pistes and 88 lifts. Further information on page 27.

3 Valley: ski pass for Warth-Schröcken as well as further ski areas in the Bregenzerwald, Lechtal and Großes Walsertal (accessible by car or bus).

SKI-IN & SKI-OUT.

For the perfect skiing day – a lot of accommodation is located right on the piste. With the Warth village railway and the village ski runs, the guaranteed snow on the Arlberg offers even more skiing pleasure! Also in Warth-Schröcken there are free ski busses that take guests comfortably and in just a few minutes right into the skiing fun. Get off the bus - on your skis - and off you go!

The village downhill runs in Warth and Schröcken run right to the front doors of most of the accommodation, so you can just jump of your skis and slip into your slippers. The two longest ski runs in the Warth-Schröcken area are the village run Nesslegg/Schröcken and the ski route across the Körpersee to Schröcken which is another crowning finale to a terrific day's skiing in Warth Schröcken.

SKI ARLBERG

In 2013 the Auenfeldjet ski lift connected the Warth-Schröcken and Lech Zürs ski areas with one another. In 2016/17 the Flexenbahn lift expanded the Ski Arlberg ski region to make this the biggest, interlinked ski area in Austria and the fifth biggest in the world.

The linking of these areas now means that all the villages on the Arlberg from Warth-Schröcken and Lech Zürs to Stuben, St Anton and St. Christoph can be accessed on skis without ski bus.

At an altitude of 1,500 to 2,800 metres and with a certainty of natural snow as well as the latest snow generating facilities, maximum skiing pleasure is therefore now guaranteed!

“RUN OF FAME” SKI ROUND TOUR.

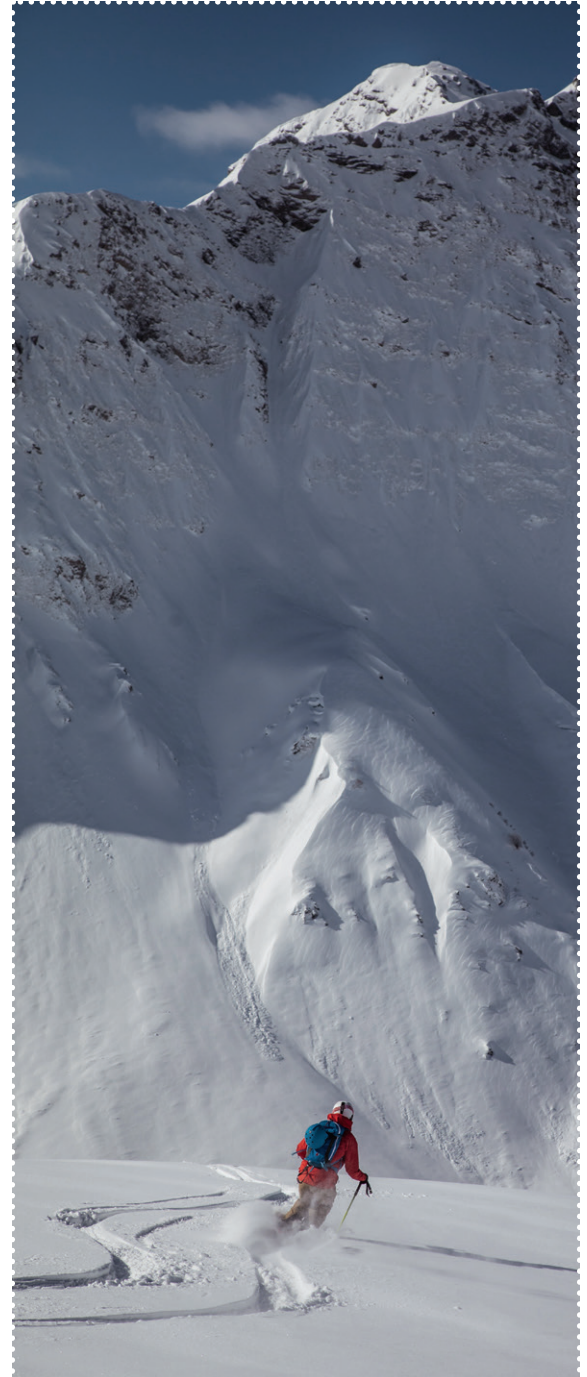

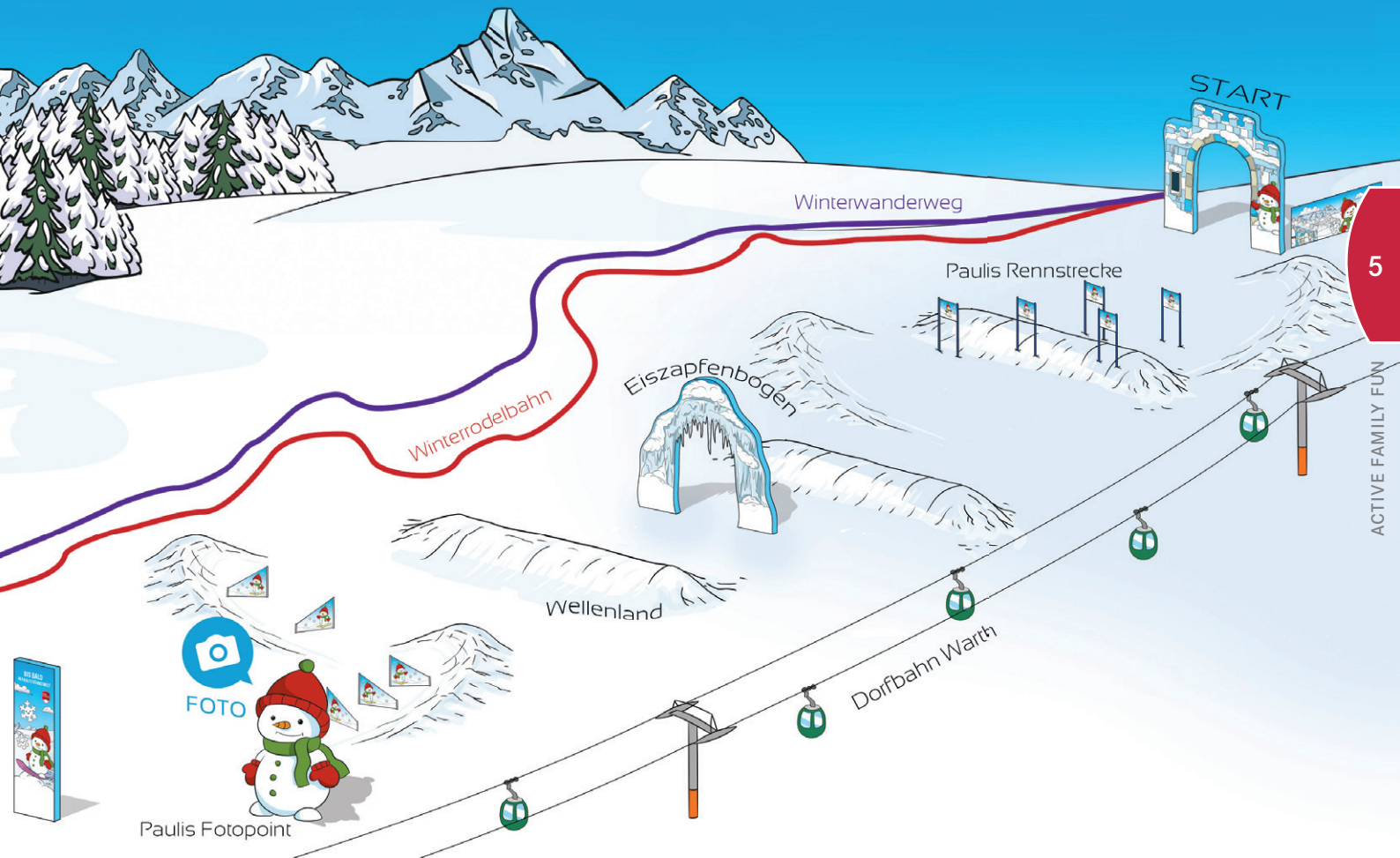

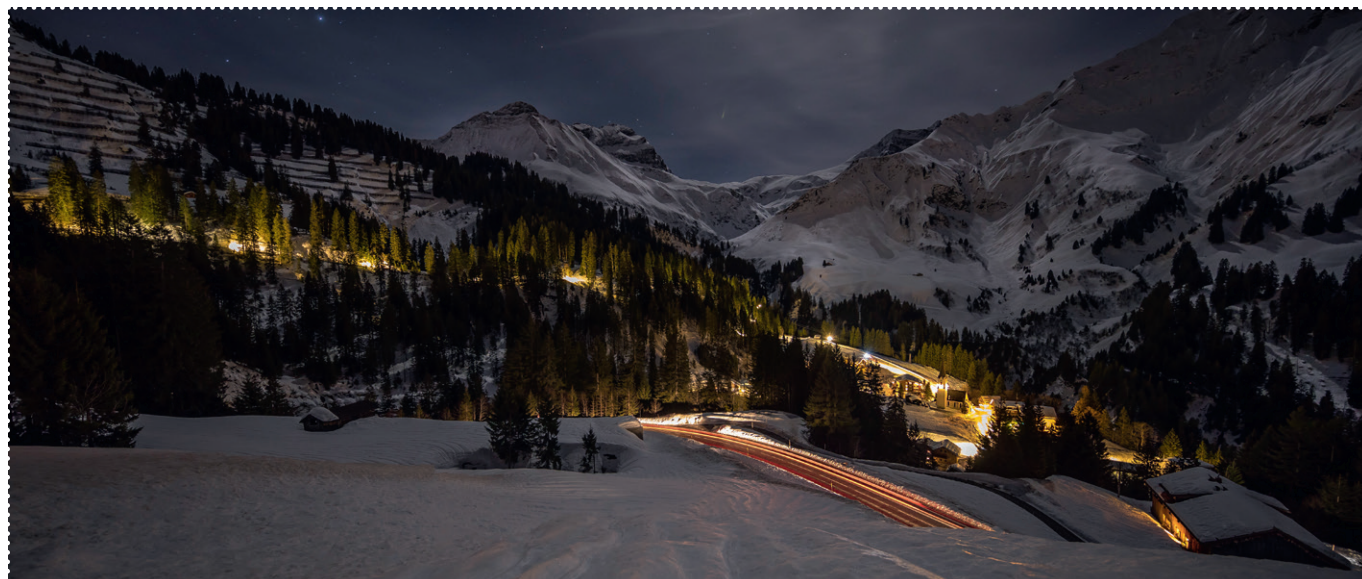
