MOUNTAIN TOURS

Moderately difficult mountain tours.



A beautiful mountain tour of medium difficulty for the entire family with a fantastic view of Warth and the surrounding peaks.

Description: ascent with the Steffisalp-Express – hiking trail in the direction of the Wartherhorn - at the Wartherhorn saddle keep left toward the summit - return the same way

TIP: guided sunrise hikes according to the weekly schedule Break options: Punschhütte, Hochalphütte

Distance 3 km | 1 hour to summit | ↑358 m | ↓358 m

HÖFERSPITZE (2,131 M). 💳



Medium-difficulty mountain tour over an exposed ridge with lovely views. Very diverse floral vegetation in June and July! Sure-footedness and a head for heights are required.

Description: start at the Hochtannbergpass - follow the "Höferspitze" hiking trail - at the zig-zag the path runs up through the pines - the path leads to the ridge via rambling hills - the path takes you up and down from the ridge to the summit - return the same way or take a detour to Schröcken-Nesslegg

TIP: guided sunset hikes according to the weekly schedule Break options: Widdersteinhütte, Hotel Adler, Restaurant/Bar Holzschopf

Distance 5.7 km | 3h total time | ↑459 m | ↓459 m

GEISSHORN (2,366 M).



A stunning hike through fairy-tale terrain and a moderately difficult but panoramic hiking trail to the summit of the Geißhorn.

Description: start at Holzplatz (between Hotel Jägeralpe and Hotel Adler) in Hochkrumbach - the trail leads over the so-called Tschirggen in the direction of the Hirschgehren alp - as soon as you have crossed the first stream, veer left onto the trail that leads steeply upward - follow this path in the direction of the Koblathütte/Koblatpass – here turn left toward the Geißhorn and follow the signage to the summit - return the same way

Break options: Hotel Jägeralpe

Distance 10 km | about 4.5 h total time | \uparrow 749 m | \downarrow 749 m



Challenging mountain tours.



Mountain tour with many vistas and a fantastic panorama at the summit. If you're lucky, you'll spot ibex on the

Description: ascent via Oberlechbahn and Petersbodenbahn – from the mountain station the path continually winds upward through the "gypsum holes" ("Gipslöcher") nature reserve, past the Kriegeralpe - follow the signposts toward Mohnensattel and continue on the gravel path to the summit - return the same way or turn right at the Mohnensattel to the Butzensee lake and continue via the Jägersteig to Schröcken (highly recommended, sure-footedness required)

TIP: On the descent, cool off in the turquoise-blue Butzensee lake. **Break options**: Kriegeralpe, restaurants in Oberlech & Schröcken

Distance 7 km | 3.5 h total time | $\spadesuit 618 \text{ m}$ | $\clubsuit 618 \text{ m}$

HOCHKÜNZELSPITZE (2,397 M).

Not very technically challenging, but you must be sure-footed and have a head for heights. A beautiful panorama over the entire Bregenzerwald area awaits you at the top.

Description: Landsteg bus stop close to Schröcken – take the agricultural road toward the Schadona pass - at the pass, turn right toward the summit - return the same way

Break options: Biberacher Hütte

Distance 14.7 km | 6h total time | \uparrow 1,412 m | \downarrow 1,412 m

BIBERKOPF (2,599 M).



Exciting, challenging mountain tour on the striking border summit of the region with rope-secured climbing routes and a fantastic panorama.

Description: from Warth-Lechleiten at the Haus Schrofenwies holiday apartments, follow the southern path toward Biberkopf - the path leads rather steeply through pine-studded terrain to an old hut - continue up to the Hundskopfalpe - via the steep grassy slopes to the entrance to the crag - rope-secured in some places, the path is challenging toward the summit (sure-footedness required) - return the same way

Break options: Holzgauerhaus in Lechleiten

Distance 6.8 km | 5 h total time | ↑ 1,078 m | ↓ 1,078 m

WIDDERSTEIN (2,533 M).



Challenging mountain tour via a somewhat rocky path to the famous peak.

Description: from the Hochtannbergpass toward the Widderstein hut - follow the path toward the Widderstein - note the signposted markings along the ascent path! - return the same way

TIP: Ascent via the east ridge (Ostgrat) or via one of the many tours offering unique alpine climbing experiences (only for experienced mountaineers!) We recommend wearing a helmet.

Break options: Widdersteinhütte, Hotel Adler

Distance 4.8 km | 4 - 4.5 h total time | ↑ 853 m | ↓ 853 m

BRAUNARLSPITZE (2,649 M).

A long, and therefore also challenging, mountain tour to the highest mountain in the Bregenzerwald - the Braunarlspitze.

Description: from Schröcken-Heimboden follow the agricultural road toward Alpe Felle - continue via the mountain hiking trail to Fürggele - an alpine track leads through rocky terrain, roped up in some places, to the summit (you must be sure-footed!) - descent to the south toward the Butzensee lake - back via the Jägersteig to Alpe Felle and return to Schröcken

TIP: Dive in to the cooling Butzensee on hot summer days! **Break options**: Gasthof Tannberg, Dorfstube, Berghaus Schröcken

Distance 15.5 km | 8 h total time | ↑ 1,529 m | ↓ 1,558 m

HIKES

Easy hikes




By taking the Steffisalp-Express, you arrive directly at the starting point of this hike, during which you will learn the history of the formerly inhabited, highest Walser settlement, Bürstegg.

Description: ascent with the Steffisalp-Express - hiking trail toward the Wannenkopf - then turn right toward Bürstegg and follow the trail down to the Walser settlement - the trail leads further via the Schöneberg in the direction of the Bodenalpe - from there, return by bus

Break options: Restaurant Bodenalpe, Restaurants in Warth

Distance 5 km | 2 - 2.5 h total time | $\spadesuit 65 \text{ m}$ | $\clubsuit 522 \text{ m}$



Beautiful hike to the Körbersee with panoramic views of the village of Schröcken.

Description: start in Schröcken-Nesslegg – across from the Restaurant/ Bar Holzschopf, the path leads over a stream - follow this trail (through the avalanche barriers) to the Körbersee - return the same way

Break options: Berghotel Körbersee, Restaurant/Bar Holzschopf

Distance 1.9 km | 1.5 h total time | \uparrow 176 m | \downarrow 12 m

NESSLEGG CIRCU



Perfect little tour with beautiful views of the surrounding mountains.

Description: from the Alpenblick bus stop in Schröcken-Nesslegg follow the access road toward Schmitte - after the Litzetobel turn right toward "Schlössle" - continue east to the "Joch" viewpoint - follow the trail down and along the main street back to the starting point

Break options: Restaurant/Bar Holzschopf

Lovely village path with fantastic views of the village. There are eight "Sichtbar" panels along the path. On them are views from the past, oriented so you can compare them to what you

Description: start from the village centre toward the church – continue to the Steffisalp-Express valley station - to the right of the Hotel Steffisalp, a path leads up and branches into the agricultural road - follow this path to the Wolfegg area - then turn left and follow the path above the village back to Warth - take a right at the tourist office toward Wälder Metzge and to the Seebachsee lake

TIP: Cool off in the Seebachsee lake Break options: Restaurants in Warth

Distance 3 km | 1 h total time | ↑86 m | ↓86 m



The Auenfeld area is characterized by immense wetland meadows and marshes, flower strewn valley floors and softly rolling hills – a true feast for the eyes!

Description: take the bus to Lech – from Oberlech-Schlössle (optional ascent with the Oberlech gondola possible) via alpine roads and footpaths to the Gaisbühelalpe - continue toward the Auenfeld saddle - turn left and continue through the Auenfeld area toward Batzenalpe (a visit to the "Uf'm Tannberg" alpine museum is highly recommended) - continue toward Schröcken - at the next fork in the path take a left toward the Alpe Felle - cross the Bergenzerach river and admire the impressive moulin - take the supply road to Schröcken

TIP: Visit the "Uf'm Tannberg" alpine museum to get a glimpse of earlier mountain farming life. **Break options**: Restaurants in Schröcken, Auenfelder Hütte

(a little bit off the path) Distance 9.4 km | 3 - 3.5 h total time | \uparrow 148 m | \downarrow 618 m



Hiking a former mule track that served for the exchange of goods between Tannberg and Southern Germany for centuries. The hike leads through a fairy-tale landscape in the border region between Austria and Germany.

Description: hike from Warth to Gehren - after the chapel in Gehren there is a small woodshed in a tight left curve, pass it on the right - directly after that the path branches off to the left and constantly ascends - follow the "Schrofenpass" signage - return the same way


Break options: Gehrnerhof

Distance 3.6 km | 2 - 2.5 h total time | ↑ 306 m | ↓ 108 m

0,5 km **1 km** 1,5 km **2 km** 2,5 km **3 km** 3,5 km **4 km** Sunny hike around Schröcken with impressive panoramic views of the village and the mountains.

Description: from Gasthof Tannberg, the path leads behind the inn toward Stutz - follow the road and after the bridge veer right to the Oberboden area- continue to the forested tract - at the fork take the right branch toward Schmitte - follow the path to Schmitte area and descent to the main road to the kiosk - here follow the main road uphill until the hiking trail branches off to the right after the first bridge follow the trail downhill to the starting point

Break options: Gasthof Tannberg, Dorfstube, Berghaus Schröcken Distance 4.4 km | 1.5 - 2 h total time | \spadesuit 223 m | \clubsuit 223 m



Two little jewels of nature in the direct vicinity of each other, surrounded by the powerful mountain backdrop of Warth-Schröcken. Ideal hike with a push chair.

Description: from the Hochtannbergpass/Salober past the Kalbelesee lake - take the leisurely footpath via the softly rolling hills toward the Körbersee lake - return the same way

TIP: Hire a row boat and go out on the Körbersee lake! **Break options**: Berghotel Körbersee Distance 3 km | 1.5 - 2 h total time | ↑ 106 m | ↓ 103 m


SUNNY TRAIL TO GEHREN & LECHLEITEN.

Easy-going, sunny hike to Gehren and Lechleiten with a view towards Warth.

Description: from the village centre of Warth toward the church follow the inlet road past Haus Anita - turn to the right, then left onto a gravel path that descents into the ravine - cross the suspension bridge and follow the signs to Gehren/Lechleiten - the path ends in a courtyard and the paved road leads through a small wood to Lechleiten - return on the same path

Break options: Gehrnerhof, Holzgauerhaus in Lechleiten, Restaurants in Warth



ALONG THE SALZSTRASSE



You reach the picturesque hilly landscape of Hochkrumbach on a former smuggler's route.

Description: next to the Hotel Steffisalp, an uphill trail leads steeply upward where the hiking path immediately branches off to the right - over a small wooden bridge, the path leads directly to the Salzstrasse and further on to Hochkrumbach - return the same way or by bus (alternatively: return on the narrow steep trail on the opposite side of the slope/across from the gallery!)

Break options: Restaurants in Warth, Wolfegg - Cafe - Bistro, Hotel Jägeralpe, Hotel Adler

TO THE MOULIN IN SCHRÖCKEN.



An exciting hike to the only moulin in the region - a fantastic natural spectacle!

Description: from the church in Schröcken – follow the old road toward the Körbersee lake to the reservoir - here take a right on the agricultural road - follow the road to the next crossing - here turn right toward the Alpe Felle - there is a slight descent to the moulin cross the Bregenzerach river and take the agricultural road past the Alpe Felle back to Schröcken

Break options: Gasthof Tannberg, Dorfstube, Berghaus Schröcken

Moderately challenging hikes.



A beautiful circuit around the Karhorn massif with diverse

alpine flora and unique views.

toward the Hochalphütte – hiking trail toward the Saloberkopf and Salobersattel - keep left in the direction of Auenfelder Hütte/Untere Auenfeldalpe - through the Auenfeld in the direction of Auenfeldsattel - keep left in the direction of Karalpe to Bürstegg - via "Steinige Bühel" in the direction of Wannenkopf - back to the Steffisalp-Express mountain station



Moderately challenging hike, also suitable for families because there are many interesting things to discover along the path, such as a natural sulphur spring, the imposing moulin, the "Uf'm Tannberg" alpine museum and the European watershed.

Description: Schröcken-Landsteg - supply road to Schröcken-Unterboden - along the Bregenzerach river through the Schröcken Adventure Park to the Stutz area - a short distance along the main road until the path branches off to the left to the Gasthof Tannberg inn go to the church and follow the supply road to Alpe Felle - continue in the direction of Batzenalpe ("Uf'm Tannberg" alpine museum) - turn left, heading to the Körbersee lake and continue to the Kalbelesee lake where you will see the European watershed - follow the trail to the Hotel Adler - take a right and climb to the World Peace Cross on the Simmel mountain and the Simmel Chapel - return by bus

Break options: Gasthof Tannberg, Dorfstube, Berghotel Körbersee, Berghaus Schröcken

Distance 11 km $\boxed{3-4h}$ total time $\boxed{\uparrow}$ 742 m $\boxed{\downarrow}$ 175 m

ALONG THE LECHWEG TRAIL FROM LECH TO WARTH.

The second leg of the Lechweg trail leads from Lech to Warth. This leg is a bit more challenging than the others due to the route of the trail, but offers beautiful views of the otherwise concealed Lech Gorge.


Description: from the Stubenbach district – follow the "L" markings

Break options: Restaurant Bodenalpe (Lech), Restaurants in Warth Distance 7.6 km | 2.5 - 3 h total time | ↑339 m | ↓306 m

ASCENT TO THE WANNENKOPF.



Short hike with some demanding parts ascending the "little brother" of the Wartherhorn with a fantastic panorama and views of the village of Warth.

Description: behind the municipality centre/tourist office in Warth, a short trailhead leads relatively steeply uphill - from here the path crosses meadows to the edge of the forest - turn left toward the Wannenkopf - a narrow, quite steep path leads between the avalanche barriers up to the "Summit" - return on the same path or via the gravel agricultural road toward the Steffisalp-Express valley station the path branches off to the right in a left curve and continues above Warth past old barns back to the starting point

Break options: Restaurants in Warth







Description: Take the Rüfikopfbahn gondola in Lech – follow the agricultural road downhill to a fork and keep left uphill - follow the mountain trail downhill toward the valley floor of the Ochsengümpele - at this level cross to the head of the valley - keep right toward the Rauhekopf saddle – continue to the Stuttgarter Hütte – descend via a steep path toward Pazüel - follow the agricultural road to Trittalpe -

continue on the paved path to Zürs - return with the hiking bus






Challenging hike requiring good physical condition and sure-footedness. You are rewarded with amazing impressions of the natural surroundings, culinary delicacies at the hut and a grandiose panorama.

Description: from the Holzgauerhaus in Lechleiten, the path climbs steeply to the Lechleitner Alpe - continue through the beautiful alpine terrain past ruined alpine huts and small lakes – follow the footpath through the somewhat rocky terrain to the Bavaria-Tirol border toward the Mutzentobel ravine - when crossing the raving you need to be sure-footed and have a head for heights because the terrain is quite steep - the trail continues to the viewpoint toward Oberstdorf - the last ascent leads to the Rappenseehütte - return the

Distance 6.6 km | 3 h to the hut | \spadesuit 687 m | \clubsuit 125 m

MINDELHEIMER HÜTTE. 💳 🔄



An alpine, cross-border hike to the Mindelheimer Hütte on old smuggler's trails.

Description: start at Holzplatz (between Hotel Jägeralpe and Hotel Adler) in Hochkrumbach - the trail leads over the so-called Tschirggen in the direction of the Hirschgehren alp – as soon as you have crossed the first stream, veer left onto the trail that leads steeply uphill - follow this path in the direction of the Koblathütte/Koblatpass - here turn left toward the Geißhorn and follow the signage to the Mindelheimer Hütte - Return: descend into the Rappenalptal valley and ascend to the Schrofenpass, continue to Gehren and take the bus back to Warth


Distance 11.5 km | about 5 h total time | ↑812 m | ↓912 m



Some stretches of the course of this hike were trodden by the Walser people from Switzerland to settle in Schröcken as early as the 17th century. Challenging hike with lovely views into the Große Walsertal valley.

Description: from Hotel Mohnenfluh in Schröcken – hiking route toward Alpe Felle - continue to the back of the Felltal valley and climb up to the waterfall (Hochgletscher) - keep right here and follow the path toward Fürggele (2,145 m) - follow the path slightly up and down to the Biberacher Hütte - descend via the wide agricultural

road to Landsteg - return by bus Distance 14.6 km | 5-6 h total time | \spadesuit 1,071 m | \clubsuit 1,247 m



Alpine hike past the unique gypsum holes and the turquoise blue Butzensee lake.

Description: ascend with the Bergbahn Oberlech and the Petersbodenbahn - follow the hiking trail through the "gypsum holes" ("Gipslöcher") nature reserve toward the Kriegeralpe - after the Kriegeralpe keep right - after a few metres turn off to the left and follow the path toward the Butzensee lake - at a fork in the trail you can turn right and descend to the Butzensee lake - otherwise follow the path through the stony terrain (follow the signposts!) to the Göppinger Hütte – descent toward the Gasthof Älpele in Zug – return by bus

Distance 13 km | 5 h total time | \uparrow 723 m | \downarrow 1,085 m
