

# SGIS JUNIOR SKIING CHAMPIONSHIPS

**PURPOSE OF THE EVENT:** To promote friendship and better understanding among all participating schools through competitive skiing.

**HOST SCHOOL:** John F. Kennedy International School, Saanen

### **SCHEDULE FOR THE DAY:**

08.30 – 09.00	Schools arrive and go directly to the bottom of the Horneggli chairlift. Lift passes can be taken at the little hut and start numbers in the Café/Restaurant Baergsunne (just before the chairlift on your right)
09.00 - 09.45	Inspection of the 1. Giant slalom course
<b>10.00</b>	First run of the giant slalom
12.00	Lunch/Picnic
12.45 – 13.15	Inspection of the 2. Giant slalom course
<b>13.30</b>	Second run
16.30	Results and presentation of prizes at the finish area
16.45	End of the event

### **RACE PROCEDURES AND REGULATIONS:**

#### 1. Categories for Individual Events:

- The competition will be **two runs** of a giant slalom. There will be two courses – a short one for categories E & F and a longer one for C & D. Results for categories E & F will be determined on the basis of each skier's best time over two runs, not the combined time. Categories C & D will also have two runs with results based on the best combined times over the two runs. **The second run for categories C & D will be reset, and skiers will race in reverse order.** Skiers who are disqualified in the first run will be allowed to do the second run, but their time will not be ranked.
- Schools are asked **not** to enter more than **5 skiers in each of the eight categories.**
- Awards:** participation prize for all, plus gold, silver and bronze medals in each of the 8 categories. Two team trophies will also be awarded - one for categories E & F and one for categories C & D.
- In order to determine the winning team, points will be awarded in the various categories as follows: first - 7 points, second - 4 points, third - 3 points, fourth - 2 points, fifth - 1 point. The school that receives the greatest point total will be declared team champion.
- The **deadline** for a school to enter the competition is **Wednesday, 9th January 2019.** After that participating schools will receive an **individualized excel entry** form by email. This form, listing the team members by category, must be emailed to [katrin@jfk.ch](mailto:katrin@jfk.ch) by **Wednesday, 23. January 2019.**
- FIS rules will be used. Skiers are not allowed through the course prior to the official start.
- Each school** will need to bring a gatwatcher (schools with more than 25 participants should bring two) – Thank you for your understanding.
- Financial obligations** of participating teams: CHF 35.- per skier for the entry fee and CHF 18.- for a ski pass. (plus depot CHF 5.00).
