**ARRIVAL BY CAR:**  
From the east: Süd Autobahn (A 2) Vienna - Graz - Klagenfurt - Villach - Spittal/Drau, or from Villach via Gegendal valley to Radenthein/Dobnach - Lake Millstätter See  
From the south: Autostrada A23 Udine - Tarvisio - Villach - Spittal/Drau, or from Villach via Gegendal valley to Radenthein/Dobnach - Lake Millstätter See  
From the west: Innsbruck - Felbertauernstrasse or Brenner Autobahn/ Pustertal Valley to Lienz - Oberdrauburg - Spittal/Drau - Lake Millstätter See  
From the north: Munich - Salzburg - Tauern Autobahn (A 10) towards Spittal/Drau, exit Lake Millstätter See (N.B.: LEFT EXIT)

**BREAKFAST ON THE MOST BEAUTIFUL LAKE TERRACES**  
The first rays of the sun move across the water, bathing the dew-covered southern shore in a luminous green glow... the perfect time of day to have breakfast on one of the most beautiful sun terraces around Lake Millstätter See. The smell of fresh bread and roasted coffee mixes with the fresh breeze blowing from the lake, inviting you to sit down... and enjoy!

**MOUNTAIN BIKING - THE GARNET TRAIL**  
Scenic bicycle trails (see bike guide), often with steep uphill climbs and rapid descents, lead cyclists along Millstätter Alm to various points of interest... there are, of course, many rest stops along the way serving specialities such as tangy alpine cheese and oven fresh bread to panoramic views of Lake Millstätter See and the Hohe Tauern.

**RELAXING AT THE 1. KÄRNTEN BADEHAUS**  
Saunas, steam baths and a 35 degree warm infinity pool with lake views await you at the 1. Kärnten Badehaus, and the Danks restaurant will spoil you with spill you with Alpe-Adria's specialities.

**A MORNING SWIM IN LAKE MILLSTÄTTER SEE**  
The first rays of the sun illuminate mystical Mount Mirnock and are reflected in the waters of Lake Millstätter See. Take a dip in the warm water and swim to the bays of the undeveloped southern shore.

**HIKING ON THE PATH OF LOVE**  
Walk across green mountains in the footsteps of the one you love, stop from time to time to take inspiration from the stories of love... along the Path of Love, Sentiero dell'Amore. There are games all around, your destination: Garnet Gate. Along the way, seven bays offer advice on interpersonal emotions, and there are many lookout points with views all the way to the Hohe Tauern that are perfect for picnicking. The home-made treats put by your host into the picnic bag are simply delicious!!!

**DINING ON LAKE MILLSTÄTTER SEE**

**DAY DISCOVERY TOURS**

**VIEW POINTS ALONG THE MILLSTÄTTER SEE ALPINE TRAIL**

**Garnet Gate**  
Inspired by the cubic architecture of the ancient Romans and Greeks, this mighty portal on Millstätter See is a reminder of Europe's largest garnet deposit.

**Steinerner Tisch**  
Its massive marble base tells the story of the Hadisch Leil, legendary giants who once lived in these mountains.

**Bewacher Stein (Guarded Stone)**  
In the same way a mountain protects its precious treasures, a cube "guards" the most valuable treasure of the Radenthein Mountains - magnesite deposits.

**Balcony of Stars**  
It is called the "Balcony of Stars" due to the reflection of the stars in the lake. From up here, it seems possible to reach up and touch the stars.

**Three Valleys View**  
This beautiful spot offers unforgettable views of the Drava Valley, Lesertal and the large Lake Millstätter See valley.

**CRAYFISH TRAIL IN FRESACH**  
In the late afternoon, our younger guests can embark on their next discovery tour to explore the habitat of the nocturnal stone crayfish. The animal is very rare in Europe, but is still found in the Wörtersbach, a creek in the mountains east of Lake Millstätter See. Wooden walkways, bridges and small viewing platforms allow visitors to observe from up-close the Crayfish Migration Trail where this "night and a shivering red armour" lives in between rocks and rocks. The 1.5 km long freely accessible Crayfish Migration Trail leads along the creek and can be chosen as a secondary route for hikes along the Lake Millstätter See Alpine Trail.

**A TIME OF DISCOVERY - EXPLORING THE SOUTHERN SHORE BY ROWING BOAT.**  
When the first rays of the sun touch the gentle waves, the time has come to explore the pristine southern shore of Lake Millstätter See. Cross the lake in an agile, timbered rowing boat and find an inviting picnic spot for the whole family, where you can relax or indulge in water games. Simply moor the boat on the small pier, unpack the picnic basket and enjoy quality time with your loved ones to views of fish and swans passing by.

**CATCH OF THE DAY**  
A warm breeze is blowing from the Hohe Tauern, and the boats are swaying gently to the rhythm of the waves. A perfect time for joining Uli and Peter Schrowsova on a fishing trip to the fishing grounds their family has owned for generations. Watch the nets being hauled in, listen to the fishing stories, smell the fried perch being prepared afterwards at the Familienhotel Post - this is precisely what a holiday at Lake Millstätter See is all about.

**BLACK PEARL**  
Captain Barbosa is looking for children that have the courage to be real pirates. Equipped with eyes patches, pirate scarfs and telescope, the captain and his crew embark on an exploration of the mysterious southern shore. **PORCIA CASTLE**  
The second floor of the Renaissance Porcia Castle accommodates the award-winning Museum of Folk Culture, while the Salamanca Cellar houses the only public gallery in Upper Carinthia. Various high-quality initial initiatives are based in Porcia Castle. **ENSEMBLE PORCIA**

**BONSAI MUSEUM**  
The Bonsai Museum in Seeboden am M. S. is the largest of its kind in Europe. It holds approximately 3,000 unique bonsai - many of the exhibits are over 100 years old. Visitors can also experience the magnificent 10,000 m<sup>2</sup> Zen garden, which was designed according to classic Japanese traditions.

**MILLSTATT MONASTERY**  
The Millstatt Monastery, which was built in around 1077, is a beautiful example of European Romanesque architecture. There is much to discover in and around the monastery: the cloister, the Larten Vell, the monastery museum, the monastery garden. It is an all year round venue for concerts as well as art and cultural events.

**SOMMERBERG CASTLE**  
Central Europe's largest museum of torture is open from April to October. In August, the castle turns into a microcosm of medieval life. Some of the main attractions are the jousting tournaments and the beautifully designed medieval market, where long forgotten crafts are brought back to life. **DIOCESAN MUSEUM**  
An intact, historic ensemble consisting of a protestant church, a tolerance prayer house and a vicarage dominate the village centre of Langalm. The Diocesan Museum serves as an exhibition and conference center for the protestant diocese of Carinthia - East Tyrol. More information can be found at:

**FIRST CARINTHIAN MUSEUM OF HANDICRAFT**  
The First Carinthian Museum of Handicraft is located inside a former monastery at the foot of the once formidable Ortenburg Castle. It accommodates more than 40 different craft workshops, e.g. of a blacksmith, wagonmaker, carpenter, shoemaker, saddler, letterpress printer, hairdresser, clock maker, merchant and rafter, and offers comprehensive insight into the working environment of past eras.

**ORTENBURG CASTLE RUIN**  
All that remains today of the former residence of the Counts of Ortenburg in Baldramsdorf are the mighty castle ruins. But all around you can still see the traces of gold prospectors who dug deep mines into the mountain in their search for gold. This also gave the mountain its name: Goldeck.
