Historic Hiking Trail

The historic hiking trail leads you through the ri leads you through the rich and fascinating history of Kufstein. We start our journey at the "Unterer Stadtplatz" (the former marketsquare), continue along the fortress rock and finish at the 1 "Unterer Stadtplatz".

The historic hiking trail consists of 23 points, walking time is 1 hour. There are topics, like

- ► the settlement of the fortress rock in the Iron age,
- ▶ the medieval fortification,
- ▶ the siege of the town and the fortress in 1504.
- ► the medieval pillory technique,
- ▶ the history of the fortress, the boat ride on the river "Inn" and the railway in Kufstein,
- ► Josef Madersperger, the inventor of sewing machines,
- ► the beautiful "Art Nouveau" buildings in Kufstein
- and much more





ARRIVING IN KUFSTEINERLAND. You're never too far away for a trip to the gateway of the Tyrolean Alps! Toll sticker requirement: Tolls are payable on all motorways and highways in Austria. For vehicles weighing up to and incl. a maximum permissible weight of 3.5 tonnes, a toll sticker (vignette) has been required since 1.1.1997 and for vehicles weighing over 3.5 tonnes, the GO toll has been applicable since 1.1.2004 (GO-Box). Toll stickers can be obtained at border crossings, petrol stations and automobile clubs.



As such, Kufsteinerland is ideally located and easy to reach by train. From Kufstein, you then have ideal access to all towns in the region.

The Meridian, a brand of Bayerische Oberlandbahn GmbH, covers the routes from Munich-Rosenheim-Salzburg/Kufstein and Munich-Holzkirchen-Rosenheim and provides guests with customer-friendly services and disabled access.



Coach parking spaces in Kufstein


For coach groups, there is a stop (hop-on and hop-off) in the upper town square, close to the fortress entrance or on the Fischergries right alongside the River Inn (near the old town parking garage, close to the lower town square). Unfortunately parking here is not possible!

For coaches, there are two free coach parking spaces available:

- Kufstein Arena coach parking space, Fischergries 22 (8 spaces)
- Wechselberger coach parking space, Salurnerstr. 2 (approx. 8 spaces)

Both coach parking spaces are just a few minutes' walk from the centre.

During certain large-scale events, an extra coach and parking system with additional spaces will be installed. Please contact us by telephone if you have any questions about parking in the villages of Kufsteinerland.

Climbing & mountaineering

Deep in the Kaisertal valley, the Hans Berger Haus mountaineering school provides the opportunity to learn comprehensive climbing skills. The famous Kaiser routes, climbing gardens, secure practice climbing tour and artificial climbing wall make this a great place to learn. The necessary equipment will be provided on-site.

Wild Kaiser for women

Female–specific climbing training. Personal development. Promoting creativity. Individual women's programmes at the lower end of the Kaisertal valley. Experience the mountains and nature around the Hans Berger Haus from a female perspective with the courses run by lodge landlady Silvia Huber. Feel. Enjoy. Sense. All of the course offers promote the uniqueness of women and their particular talents. An exceptional energy centre in the mountains where the heart, mind and humour dominate.



Biking & cycling

Enjoyable routes in the valley. Along the River Inn. Through forests and meadows. Those who love a challenge will find what they are looking for here in the mountains. The diverse natural landscapes of Tyrol are a paradise for cyclists. From gentle ascents to tours of the Alpine terrain, the mountains of Kufsteinerland in Tyrol are home to endless routes. As part of the world's largest e-biking region, Kufsteinerland is particularly well-equipped when it comes to e-biking services, hire and charging stations.

Racing bikers will enjoy the wide range of routes on offer. The sporting competition for racing bikers is the Kufsteinerland Cycling Marathon through Kufsteinerland (complete with attractive biking-related side events) which has been taking place since 2016. Those seeking cycling enjoyment over a longer distance will appreciate the two long-distance cycle tracks which run through Kufsteinerland. Explore the gateway to the Tyrolean Alps on two wheels! Booklet of bike tours is available at the Tourist Board.



Bike Trail Tyrol

Through gorges. Along crashing streams. Up steep hills. Through idyllic fields and meadows. Pure challenge. Enjoyable plains. Up and down through the mountains of Tyrol. The 'Bike Trail Tirol' is the longest continuous circular mountain biking course in the Alps. 32 stages. 1,000 km. 27,000m of altitude. One day or multi-day circular tours. From the town into the countryside and vice versa. With its unique mountain landscapes around the Kaisergebirge, Kufsteinerland forms part of the 'Bike Trail Tirol'. The historic urban flair of the fortress town close to nature forms the start and end point. Stage 9 of the 'Bike Trail Tirol' runs from the Kaiserhaus to Kufstein. Stage 10 runs from Kufstein to Kössen.



Swimming & Bathing

Fun and action with a big dose of well-being and recuperation are a top priority at the 6 swimming baths in Kufsteinerland. The pools are dotted across the region so there is always some water-based fun nearby. Dive in. Submerse yourself. Enjoy.

Bathing

While the 6 bathing lakes of Kufsteinerland have many differences, there is also one thing which unites these 6 sparkling pearls at the heart of Tyrol's natural landscape. Top water quality. And Tyrol's mountains as a backdrop. Kufsteinerland's water-based options range from peaceful and idyllically situated pools to sporty pools.



Riding

Sit firm in the saddle. Explore Kufsteinerland at the pace of these animals. Impressive moments to set the pulses of horse riders racing! The pearl of Kufstein is the starting point for numerous activities relating to sport, nature and health. The region's comprehensive range of cultural and culinary offers is unique in this combination.

Winter in Kufsteinerland is marked by its captivating Advent and Christmas markets, followed by the high calibre winter festival in Erl. The ski piste is almost directly accessible from the town thanks to the nearby SkiWelt Wilder Kaiser Brixental. Beginners, families and those wishing to adopt a more leisurely approach are in the best of hands on the pistes of Kufsteinerland. As one of the most accessible Alpine living areas, Kufsteinerland is perfect for practising winter sports such as snow shoe walks, cross-country, sledging and skating on the lake, virtually on the hotel doorstep!

And when it comes to hotels: in Kufsteinerland, guests can choose between excellent hotels, health resorts, ultra-modern accommodation and traditional guesthouses.



Skating & Sledging

On the artificial ice rinks and, when the weather is cooperating, on Lakes Hechtsee and Thiersee. In and around the fortress town, there are lots of possibilities for enjoying skating. Pure natural pleasure. Gliding across frozen lakes and practising pirouettes on the ice rink. There are also various covered ice rinks in Ebbs and Kufstein.

Sledging


