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# Living traditions

**A marriage of baroque festival culture and modern joie de vivre – be inspired by a fascinating journey back in time to the year 1719!**

“Man muss die Feste feiern, wie sie fallen” (a German saying meaning “holidays should be celebrated on the days on which they fall”). And this has been the case ever since the time of Augustus the Strong. The marriage between his son, Frederick Augustus, and the Austrian emperor’s daughter, Maria Josepha, was held in September 1719 and celebrated for four whole weeks. A dazzling wedding which saw Saxony at the peak of its powers, and which combined all the elements of royal festival culture, including hunts, a ball, an opera, jousting and serenades. And the celebrations were not just held at the Royal Palace but at all the sites that continue to define Dresden’s old town district to this day. Goddesses acted as godmothers, and the highlight of the Planets Festival in the romantic Plauenscher Grund region revolved around Saturn, in commemoration of the mining industry to which Saxony owed its wealth. So in the year marking its 300th anniversary, it is only appropriate to indulge in some extended, glamorous and varied celebrations once again – at many different locations, featuring illustrious guests, and with an awareness of tradition while still keeping up with the times. Dresden is prepared and in 2019 the whole city will become a stage.

## State rooms and horse droppings

Restoration of another section of Europe’s finest treasure house, Dresden’s Royal Palace, will conclude just in time for the 300th wedding anniversary – and it couldn’t be more fitting, with the five ceremonial halls originally built for the wedding of Elector Frederick Augustus and Maria Josepha reaching completion. These state rooms were modelled on the French style, comprising two antechambers, a dining room, an audience chamber, and the state sleeping quarters, with a grand, four-metre-high bed. The double-height small ballroom, reconstructed in the historicist style, has also been reopened. With these rooms, the Royal Palace has regained both its centrepiece and its original baroque opulence.

The Zwinger, built under the direction of architect Matthäus Daniel Pöppelmann and sculptor Balthasar Permoser in the early 18th century, played a central part in the celebrations. Just as the Jupiter Festival reflected the baroque world view at the time, as a spectacle for all the senses, the new 3D interactive museum in Bogengalerie L (arched gallery) will similarly embrace diversity and joie de vivre in a very modern way. It is dedicated to the history of Dresden’s central landmark, and focuses on the wedding celebrations of 1719, which are also the subject of exhibitions at other Dresden museums. The Armoury, for example, provides insights into “royal attire”, presenting the prized “royal regalia” of the time, while the Transport Museum features a special exhibition entitled “Of splendid gondolas, lavish carriages, and horse droppings”, which provides animated insights into what it meant for guests to “travel to the wedding of the century in 1719.”





# The modern era conquers the old fortress

2019 will see Dresden Fortress play host to a festival that once again cannot escape reference to the 1719 royal wedding. Because just as the wedding was dedicated to the seven planets, so the planets also lent their names to the 16th-century bastions. A modern exhibition is now set to open at the defence complex under Brühl's Terrace. "Festivals. Drama. Catastrophes. Closer than ever before." brings 450 years of Dresden history to life in a spectacular multimedia installation.

Historic highlights include Augustus the Strong's passion for collecting – which laid the foundations for the Dresden State Art Collections. This passion was continued by King Augustus III, the groom of the 1719 wedding, who brought objects such as Raphael's Sistine Madonna to Dresden. But while Meissen porcelain, the treasures of the Green Vault, and the "Old Masters" may have established the collection's reputation, art history has kept evolving. Bauhaus is also celebrating an anniversary in 2019. One hundred years ago, Walter Gropius established Weimar as the home of the avant-garde of classical modernity. Ten years prior, construction had already begun on Germany's first "garden city" – Hellerau – the north of Dresden. Here Reform architects created a district of modern country houses and smaller estate houses, with its Festival Theatre as a centre of culture, particularly modern dance.

The State Art Collections will be hosting the "Spaces of the Future. Kandinsky, Mondrian, Lissitzky in Dresden 1919 to 1932" exhibition in the Albertinum starting in March, demonstrating that modern art has indeed also left a legacy of its own in Dresden.

## A major reading festival and a little boy

With its almost 1100-year-long history, Meissen is considered to be the "cradle" of Saxony, and Albrechtsburg castle and the cathedral perched high above its ancient narrow street and the River Elbe are evidence of this. Meissen has been known for its fine porcelain for almost 300 years. But it is also of significance to the German language, with Martin Luther using Meissen's "chancellery language" (Kanzleideutsch) – a precursor of Standard German considered to be superior to local dialects – for his translation of the Bible. So it is no coincidence that Germany's largest open-air reading festival is being held here. In the second week of June, the city will play host to history and stories. Some 200 events held in historic squares, picturesque alleyways and courtyards, and romantic buildings will see works read by authors, actors, artists, and representatives from politics and business – all free of charge and nearly all dialect-free.

There was presumably no Meissen porcelain at Number 66 Königsbrücker Strasse back in 1899. Ida Kästner was sewing shirtwaists; "it was tough going for a few pennies". On 23 February she gave birth to a son and called him Emil Erich, never dreaming he would one day become a great writer, or that "Emil and the Detectives" would become his best known children's book. In his book "When I was a Little Boy" (Als ich ein kleiner Junge war) he describes the city of his childhood. Today a monument to him stands on Albertplatz, near his rich uncle's mansion, which has housed the Erich Kästner Museum and "Villa Augustin" literature centre for the last twenty years. ## 55 kilometres of pure pleasure

The Dresden Elbland region combines the famous art city of Dresden and one of Germany's most beautiful cultural landscapes, where the River Elbe is lined with vineyards, picturesque towns, romantic castles and palaces, and a vast forest and lake district. Apart from the cultural aspects, visitors here can also expect culinary diversity and a wide range of places to stay.

The 55-km Saxon Wine Route runs through the Elbe Valley from Pirna, the gateway to Saxon Switzerland, to Dresden and Meissen, and onwards to the quaint Elbe wine-growing villages, and thus through Europe's north-easternmost wine-growing region, whose history dates back 850 years. Homely restaurants, wineries and seasonal wine taverns in the vineyards line the Wine Route and river, which can incidentally also be cruised on vessels from the world's largest and oldest paddle-steamer fleet. The "Sächsische Weinwanderweg" wine hiking trail, with its many lookout points, also runs through the Elbe's hillsides, parallel to the Saxon Wine Route. The series of autumn wine festivals opens with the "Tage des offenen Weingutes" (Open Winery Day) on the last weekend in August, which will this year be held for the 20th time. Many wineries and seasonal wine taverns offer 3-wine tastings and tours through the vineyards and cellars; entry is free and shuttle buses operate regularly between the wineries. The largest of these wineries is the Sächsisches Staatsweingut Schloss Wackerbarth. Located at the foot of the Radebeul vineyards, it is Europe's first interactive winery, featuring a unique baroque castle complex and grounds, a historic wine-growing landscape, and modern winemaking facilities.

## 50 and not old at all

You can't have a wedding without music. But in 1719, they didn't just limit themselves to church concerts, serenades and musical comedies; they built a new opera house at the Zwinger, which was opened by Antonio Lotti during the wedding. Three hundred years later, his operas are still being performed – and once again in a new concert hall.

A state-of-the-art venue has recently been built for the Dresden Philharmonic Orchestra at the Kulturpalast am Altmarkt, though the building itself will be celebrating its 50th birthday in 2019. First advertised as a "house of socialist culture" in an architecture competition in 1959, the Kulturpalast was officially inaugurated in October 1969 as the largest venue in the GDR at the time. Designed by head architect Wolfgang Hänsch in the centre of the city, the building was later added to the list of heritage monuments, as well as the heavily ideological "Kunst am Bau" scheme. But the old multi-purpose hall no longer met the requirements of a modern concert hall, and, in 2008, the city council decided to redesign it as a contemporary interpretation of the 1950s "arts centre" featuring a concert hall, library, cabaret theatre and foyer. The new concert hall was designed and built by renowned architectural firm Gerkan, Marg and Partners, which worked closely with Dutch acoustics firm Peutz to optimise the conditions inside the heritage-listed building. The result is not simply a concert hall, but rather a Palace of the Arts. And visitors can see this for themselves at anytime, including during the 50th-anniversary celebrations.

The Kreuzkirche on Dresden's Altmarkt is the city's main Lutheran church, and seat of the regional bishop of Saxony. Seating more than 3,000, it's the largest church building in Saxony. It is also a centre of church music, being home to the Dresdner Kreuzchor boys' choir and the Kreuzkirche organists. The weekly vespers, attracting several thousand listeners, have been held at the Kreuzkirche Dresden continuously, without fail, since 1371. Reports from every century attest to the vespers' unique appeal to visitors from near and far. There is music from the Dresdner Kreuzchor boys' choir, reputable soloists and orchestras, as well as renowned guest ensembles, with a very varied programme, ranging from elaborate cantata performances to world-class a-capella music.
