## Rotarians in Caorle



Our event is part of a European stage of the Flying Rotarians and will attract a large number of Rotarian visitors from all over Europe who, on this occasion, will come to Caorle to attend exciting flight shows, as well as to participate in numerous collateral activities.

The event, like most of the Rotarian activities, has its own service which is aimed at people with disabilities, but they also want a unique opportunity to promote the beauty of the historic seaside village of Caorle.

The pilots of the WEFLY aerobatic team were also invited to the event dedicated to flight-loving Rotarians who are dedicated to the cause and assistance of people with disabilities. a school for disabled children in Caorle. The event was possible thanks to the help of the Municipal Administration of Caorle, the participation of the fellowship of the Italian Flying Rotarians, the fellowship of the Flying Rotarians of District 2060, the interclub between different Rotarian Clubs of District 2060, the Rotarian friends of the club of Graz (Austria), as well as the "HAG" vintage aircraft association and the Volo a Mare sports association which manages the Caorle airfield.

Furthermore, the event enjoys a partnership with the Italian Air Force.





## Caorle

#### An enchanting seafaring village on the upper Adriatic Sea

Fine sand beach sloping gently towards the sea, a timeless natural lagoon, the old town centre, revealing still nowadays the past life and tradition of its inhabitants: these are some of the elements that make Caorle one of the most favourite tourist destinations in Italy.



Famous for its old town centre that recalls the city of Venice with its campi, calli and colourful houses, Caorle is immersed in an area where nature has remained untouched and blends with the millenary traditions of a fishing village.

A fantastic landscape to fly over, where Land and Sea blend in breathtaking colours: from the green of the Vallevecchia Natural Oasis to the blue of the Adriatic Sea, up to the yellow of the very fine sand.



## Caorle

#### Caorle cuisine between tradition and innovation

There is an indissoluble link between cuisine and territory, and the food and wine experience is a key element in the discovering of a place and its identity. Gourmet destination in the Upper Adriatic, the fishing village of Caorle makes its cuisine its best calling card, offering an interesting travel motivation not only for gourmets.







The very fresh fish is the flagship of the Caorlotta cuisine: dormouse, white canestrello and organic sea clams.

The very fresh catch is the flagship of the Caorlotta cuisine which can count on three highly appreciated local fish products: the musky octopus, a small octopus that loves sandy seabeds, perfect as a low-calorie appetizer and an excellent natural anti-wrinkle thanks to the high percentage of collagen which contains; the white canestrello, a mollusc with a delicate flavour often prepared on the grill; organic sea clams (unique certification in all of Italy) farmed in the area in front of Vallevecchia, a protected naturalistic area and Site of Community Interest.



Caught along the coast, they are the protagonists of the historical Municipal Fish Market: here, in the area adjacent to the fishing port, the sale takes place, with a traditional system called auction 'by ear'.

And if the sea is synonymous of history and quality, the hinterland also suggests flavours that deserve to be tasted, such as superfine Carnaroli rice, sandbank honey, Montasio DOP cheese, craft beer or local wines. A rich basket of products offered in a Caorlotto menu that conquers even the most difficult palates, to be tried in the characteristic restaurants of the village: not to be missed are the classic spaghetti with clams, baby octopus stewed with polenta, risotto with white canestrelli, sardines in Saor, bigoli in sauce or grilled fish.
