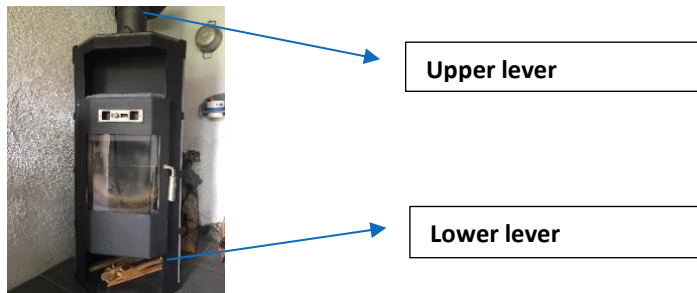

Kitchen

Wood-burning stove: To light the fire, pull out the lower lever and position the upper lever vertically. Once the embers are glowing, push the lower lever all the way in and position the upper lever horizontally.



Appliances: Microwave, oven, Nespresso capsule coffee machine, milk frother, hand blender, toaster, Cheese fondue set, Chinese fondue set, and Burgundy fondue set (gas, petrol, or paste-powered), various gratin dishes, pressure cooker, various pots and pans, raclette oven, egg boiler, spaetzle strainer, mixing bowl, cake pan, etc.

Spices, oil, vinegar, fresh herbs, sugar, flour, tea, and a pack of coffee capsules: Coffee capsules are provided to get your vacation off to a good start.

Drinking water: Healthy spring water. A soda maker (Sodastream) is available for sparkling water.

Large knives, aluminum foil, and plastic wrap: Located in the drawer under the oven.

Lighting: To turn on the under-cabinet lighting in the kitchen, use this switch located by the front door:



The switches for the outdoor lights are also in the kitchen:



Outdoor street light (glows red when on)

Light for the arbor and entrance (on when in the upright position)

Laundry / Cleaning / Sewing / Ironing / Trash / Keys

Cleaning supplies: Under the sink; additional cleaning supplies and toilet and paper towels in the gazebo (outdoor room, small door next to the main door).

Vacuum cleaner: Cordless Dyson vacuum cleaner in the coat closet. There is a standard vacuum cleaner in the arbor (dust bag also in the arbor) and an additional vacuum cleaner (without dust bag) on the upper floor in the large bedroom behind the closet.

Laundry: Washing machine and dryer in the bathroom.

Clotheslines and a small drying rack in the arbor. An ironing board and iron are in the closet in the master bedroom. Laundry detergent is in the laundry cabinet and is available for your use.

Sewing kit: In the closet in the hallway on the upper floor.

Trash can: In front of the front door. This is because ashes are also disposed of there. Small trash can (chrome bowl with plastic bag) on the kitchen counter. Trash bags are located under the sink. Please dispose of the trash bags in the containers on Grubengasse. Unfortunately, there are no composting facilities in the municipality. Kitchen waste must therefore be disposed of in the trash.

Disposal of glass, metal, aluminum, cardboard, and paper: See the waste separation system in the arbor. We're happy to dispose of it for you. Otherwise, there's a glass recycling collection point across from the Hotel Bären.

Keys: Hanging behind the front door. Please return the front door key to the key box in the gazebo. A second house key is on the table. Please return it there before departure.

Living Room

Lamps: In the living room, you can control the three small mood lamps with the remote control (ABC buttons, right button to turn on/left button to turn off):

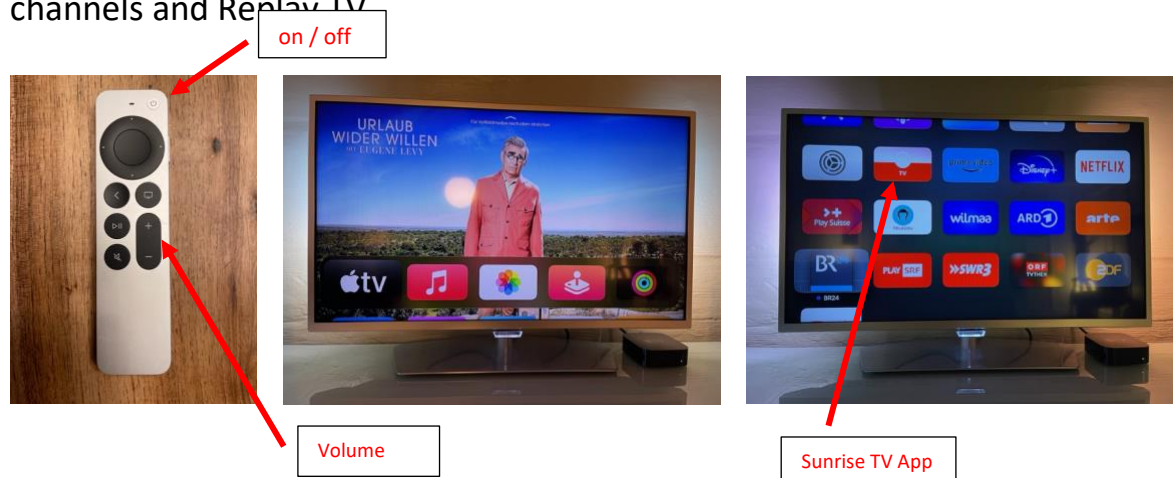


TV: Android Smart TV with various apps installed, such as Sunrise TV, Netflix, YouTube, wilmaa, Disney, Play Suisse, Zattoo, Teleboy, ARD, arte, ZDF, etc. (no subscription required; simply log in with your personal subscription)

Apple TV: Download the “Apple TV” app for iOS (via the App Store) or for Android (via the Google Play Store) onto your device and stream directly from your smartphone to the TV: Turn on and operate the Apple TV box using the small silver remote control.

Alternatively, you can watch TV directly via the pre-installed apps on your Smart TV. You can also download additional apps there.

Via the Sunrise TV app, you have access to 275 domestic and international channels and Replay TV.



You can listen to **the radio** via Bluetooth on the Libratone speaker. Five stations are pre-installed. Or use the radio apps on the Smart TV or your own.



WIFI: You’ll find the Wi-Fi login on the round table in the living room, inside the small picture frame.

Bathroom

Bath towels are provided. Beach towels and a hair dryer can be found in the cabinets.

Turn **the underfloor heating in** the upper bathroom to “on” and use the up arrow to increase the heat. There is also a quick heater.

Underfloor heating in the lower bathroom: Set to “on” and use the up arrow key.

Towel warmer: Turn on at the switch in the upper left corner.

The instruction manual for **the steam shower** in the lower bathroom is in the magazine rack next to the toilet. The manuals for the **washing machine** and **dryer are there** as well.

Master bedroom

Bookshelf: A selection of various books, including some in English and French. Please put them back before you leave.

Large closet: The right half of the closet (as seen from the front) is locked (private).

Duvet covers are provided (also in the smaller bedroom).

Balcony

It has a table and chairs for two people and is protected from the rain. For four people, there is a longer board next to it that can be placed over the tabletop.

Garden

You enter the larger garden through a rose arch. There is also a barbecue area there. Deck chairs, cushions, a parasol, a kettle grill, and charcoal can be found in the tool shed in front of the garden, as well as metal oil lamps and lamp oil for outdoor use.

The password for the lock is 1234. Additional lounge chairs and umbrellas are in the basement.

Please note that quiet hours begin at 10:00 PM.

Tourism/Surroundings

Guest Card: Discounts at various locations in the Interlaken region; trains and buses are free. The guest card is available for you in the apartment. You’ll also find many brochures there. The tourist office is located on the village square. (50 m from the house; take the small path up the stairs).

Shopping: In the village, there is the PRIMA village store (Röthlisberger) near Hotel Bären (Monday through Sunday, 6:30 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.). In Interlaken, you’ll find a wide variety of shops as well as larger shopping centers such as Migros (near the West Station) and Coop (near the East Station).

Restaurants: In Ringgenberg itself, there are the following restaurants serving Swiss cuisine: The highly recommended Restaurant Q (burgseeli.ch, dogs not

allowed inside), the Taproom Braui (burgbier.com) with pizzas and other small dishes, and the Hotel Bären (baeren-ringgenberg.ch, simple cuisine, bar service). Next to the Taproom is Ändels Backstube with delicious baked goods (ändelsweb.ch). Numerous restaurants in Interlaken.

Hiking guides: Various hiking guides for the region are available in the living room.

Transportation: Bus: 50 m toward the village square/tourist office. Train: 7-minute walk along the tracks, under the bridge, then cross to the left side of the bridge. Schedule: sbb.ch

Swimming: Brienersee swimming area right after the cemetery, across from the castle. Burgseeli (usually around 25 degrees) is a 15-minute walk away. By car, you can reach Merligen in 20 minutes, where there is a beautiful public outdoor thermal pool at the Hotel Beatus Merligen (beatus.ch). In Interlaken, the indoor pool features a lovely wellness area with a whirlpool offering views of the Jungfrau. In summer, there is a swimming pool with a water slide in front of it.

Sailing: Sailboat rentals next to the Hotel Neuhaus (segelschule-neuhaus.ch). Motorboat rentals (even without a license) can be found in Iseltwald (abegglenwerft.ch) and on Lake Thun at thunersee.ch

Golf: There is a golf course in Interlaken that requires a handicap of 36 (interlakengolf.ch). In Grindelwald, there is a beautiful golf course (golf-grindelwald.ch) below the north face of the Eiger, which can be played without a course permit. Two beautiful golf courses are located 20 minutes by car toward Thun: Golf Thunersee (golftthunersee.ch) and Golf Aaretal (golfaaretal.ch).

Walk: A lovely walk takes you from the house toward the village square, down to Seeburg, and along the lake until you return to the village. From there, walk through the houses (very little traffic) back to the house, approx. 30 min.

Another very pleasant walk leads from the house toward Augst-Mathorn, then toward Schadburg to Niederried, where you take the lakeside path back to Ringgenberg—about 2 hours. Longer hikes starting from the house:
