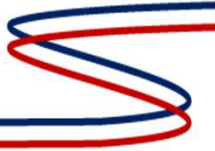

ABOUT THE MASTERS WORLD CUP

Every year the World Masters Cross-Country Ski Association hands over an unofficial world championship in cross-country skiing, the so-called "Masters World Cup" (short: MWC) to a club for organizing and hosting this event.

After 20 years the SCMK Hirschau has been awarded to organize the MWC in 2023 in Seefeld again. The MWC 2023 will take place from

18th March till 24th March 2023 in Seefeld-Tirol (A)

The Masters World Cup is not only addressed at top athletes who still have the ambition to achieve great results even in old age, but also recreational athletes for whom health and the urge to exercise are paramount.

For the MWC 2023, the SCMK Hirschau expects more than 1,000 athletes from 25 nations who will participate on 5 competition days in up to 3 individual competitions + relay, divided into the respective age groups (from the age of 30 years).

As a **patron** for the event we could win the 4-time Olympic Participant and 2-time overall World Cup Winner in cross-country skiing, **Mr. Tobias Angerer**. At different World Championships and Olympic Games he has won in total 11 medals in his career.

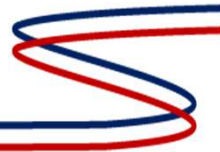
The event program with daily award ceremonies, ski and material test, sales booths, etc. will make the Masters World Cup 2023 to a successful event for athletes, spectators and guests.

ABOUT THE SC MONTE KAOLINO HIRSCHAU e.V.

The organizer SC Monte Kaolino Hirschau e.V. won the first German Championship title with its promising young talents, practically out of nowhere. In the following decades, the athletes succeeded in winning numerous national and international awards for SC Monte Kaolino Hirschau.

Jochen Behle, Peter Schlickerrieder, Holger Bauroth, Uwe Bellmann are just a few examples. They not only participated in the Olympic Games, but they were also very successful in World Championships.

The ski club SC Monte Kaolino Hirschau with its more than 420 members has been the organizer of regional, national and international cross-country skiing competitions over a period of more than 5 decades until today.

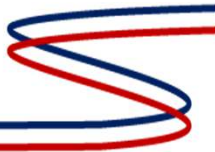

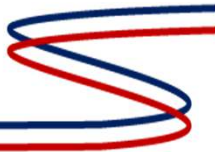
