*The River Film Festival is preparing to celebrate its twentieth anniversary, expanding its program with two new sections: **feature films** and **artificial intelligence**.*

Cinema, in its many forms and genres—feature films, short films, virtual reality, and AI, from fiction to animation and documentary—is one of the privileged languages through which our time reflects upon itself.

Since its origins, cinema has embodied a distinctly philosophical tension: making the invisible visible. Directors such as Andrei Tarkovsky and Ingmar Bergman explicitly conceived cinema as a meditation on time, memory, and transcendence.

Contemporary cinema continues this tradition, but with a new urgency: to tell the story of a world marked by technological acceleration, identity crises, and universal values that have become meaningless. Film thus becomes a "collective consciousness" that thinks in images. From a philosophical and metaphysical perspective, it does not merely tell stories—it becomes a tool to question reality, time, identity, and the meaning of existence.

Now more than ever, amid the current geopolitical crisis, the River Film Festival is navigating by sight: we do not know which of the filmmakers in competition will be able to attend the long-awaited screenings, whether due to canceled flights or threats to their own lives—especially our Iranian guests, to whom we have dedicated a special evening.

We wish our audience an enjoyable viewing.

For twenty years, on these banks, the River Film Festival has had the rare power to renew those who enter its orbit. It does so by offering original, different perspectives, capable of delving deep into the themes of our present and of questioning a world in continuous, frantic transformation, where even the role of cinema — and of the humanity that creates it, moves through it, dreams it — is constantly being called into question.

These new Twenties are difficult times, "heavy", as my dear Marty McFly would say in "Back to the Future". Times in which we move seamlessly from resignation to the desire for redemption, from exhaustion to the pursuit of sparks of enthusiasm, without ever truly giving ourselves the time to stop. We often move forward breathlessly, searching for a safe shore.

And in order to find it, being able to look through the eyes of our filmmakers is a priceless privilege. They take us where we could never arrive without them: they offer us worlds, visions, perspectives. And, almost before we realise it, they become part of us.

For me, who have spent only two years on these banks, this is exactly what happened. Watching more than three hundred works was a journey that is difficult to truly recount. Selecting 138 of them forced me to go through a form of personal, artistic and, in some way, also political growth. Because helping the journey of the selected films continue through the eyes of others means taking on a responsibility. For better or worse, it means caring for them.

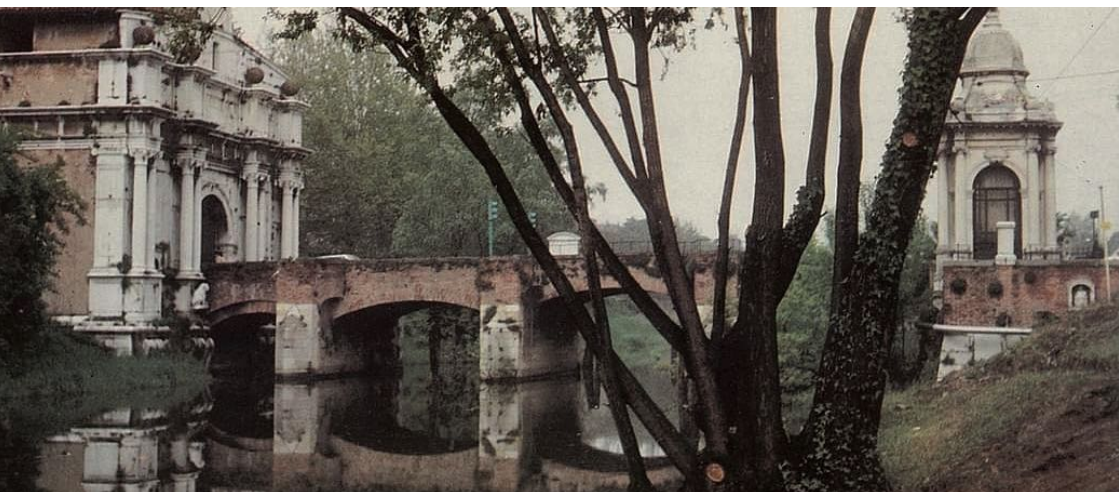

EMILIO DELLA CHIESA Direzione Artistica | *Festival Director*

Emilio Della Chiesa, architetto e direttore artistico del River Film Festival, ha iniziato la sua carriera nel cinema con documentari musicali di Brian Eno, John Lourie, Arto Lindsay e Lidia Lunch. Ha partecipato regolarmente a Città in Cinema a L'Aquila, dove ha preso parte a stage e workshop con molti dei più grandi registi della fotografia, Rotunno, Storaro, Alekan, Almendros, Bayle, Zsigmond e altri, dopo di che è diventato membro dell'AIC (Associazione Italiana Autori della Fotografia Cinematografica).

Emilio è stato influenzato dalla personalità di Joris Ivens, che ha incontrato alla Mostra del Cinema di Venezia dove ha lavorato per oltre 30 anni come proiezionista. A Venezia incontra anche molte delle grandi personalità del cinema, come Fellini e Bergman. Ha continuato la sua formazione nel cinema lavorando prima come assistente, poi operatore e poi direttore della fotografia presso la scuola di Olmi per 12 anni. Successivamente è stato membro della giuria in vari festival in tutto il mondo. Come direttore della Fotografia ha realizzato diversi documentari, lungometraggi e cortometraggi.

Emilio Della Chiesa, architecture and artistic director of the River Film Festival, began his career in cinema with music documentaries featuring Brian Eno, John Lurie, Arto Lindsay, and Lydia Lunch. He regularly took part in "Città in Cinema" in L'Aquila, where he attended workshops and training sessions with some of the greatest cinematographers, including Rotunno, Storaro, Alekan, Almendros, Bayle, Zsigmond, and others. He later became a member of the AIC (Italian Association of Cinematographers).

Emilio was influenced by the personality of Joris Ivens, whom he met at the Venice Film Festival, where he worked for over 30 years as a projectionist. In Venice, he also met many of the great figures of cinema, such as Fellini and Bergman. He continued his film education by working first as an assistant, then as a camera operator, and later as a director of photography at Olmi's school for 12 years. He subsequently served as a jury member at various festivals around the world. As a director of photography, he has worked on several documentaries, feature films, and short films.



MARTA BRUNO Vice Direttrice | *Deputy Director*

Innamorata del cinema alle prime visioni, a 10 anni, contagiata dai suoi genitori e da "Effetto Notte" di Truffaut. Laureata in design della comunicazione, si è diplomata in regia cinetelvisiva alla Scuola Civica di Cinema Luchino Visconti, è stata montatrice, assistente di un regista pubblicitario, autrice e redattrice televisiva per Rai 2, DeAgostini - DeAbyDay, La3 TV.

She fell in love with cinema at an early age, attending first screenings at just 10 years old, inspired by her parents and by "Day for Night" by Truffaut. She holds a degree in Communication Design and graduated in film and television directing from the Scuola Civica di Cinema Luchino Visconti. She has worked as an editor, assistant to an advertising director, and as a television writer and editor for Rai 2, DeAgostini - DeAbyDay, and La3 TV.

La sua apertura e competenza le hanno permesso di costruire relazioni solide, amichevoli e sincere con registi, attori, produttori, agenti di vendita, nonché con giornalisti locali e internazionali. Grazie alla sua vasta rete di contatti nell'industria cinematografica, è sempre aperta a nuove sfide e ama promuovere film africani e arabi.

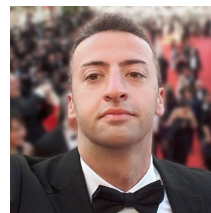
It's been over 35 years since Brigitta Portier has been active in the film industry. It all started back in 1986 when she was in charge of the TV call at the Cannes Film Festival. Her main role was handling all the requests of International Publicist's requiring interview spaces during the Festival. This led to International Publicist Richard Lormand asking her to become his assistant. After two years working with Richard, Brigitta decided to create her own company 'Alibi Communications' and since then she has been the International Publicist for over 300 films at all the major film festivals around the world. Her gift for languages (fluent: Dutch, French, English, German, Italian, Spanish) along with her passion for cinema has played a significant part in her success. Her openness and knowledge have enabled her to create a good, friendly, honest relationships with Directors, Actors, Producers, Sales Agents as well as Local and International Journalists. With all her connections within the film industry she is always open to new challenges and loves promoting African and Arabic films.

Prima di entrare a far parte di HKBU, il Prof. Kim è stato Professore presso la Media School e Direttore dell'Institute for Convergence Culture della Hallym University, in Corea del Sud. Eletto Presidente della Korean Association for Public Diplomacy per il 2025, il Prof. Kim è Editor-in-Chief del Korean Social Science Journal, la principale rivista accademica del Korean Social Science Council (KSSC), un'associazione che riunisce quindici organizzazioni accademiche nazionali nelle scienze sociali e negli studi di management. L'area di ricerca e insegnamento del Prof. Kim comprende cinema e televisione, cultura e industrie creative, politiche dei media ed economia politica, nonché media globali. Recentemente, il Prof. Kim ha coordinato un progetto di ricerca nazionale quinquennale sulla modellizzazione dello sviluppo ICT della Corea ed è attualmente impegnato nello studio dell'impatto della narrazione nell'ambito delle scienze umane.

Before joining HKBU, Prof. Kim was a Professor at the Media School & the Director of the Institute for Convergence Culture, Hallym University, South Korea. Elected as the President of the Korean Association for Public Diplomacy for 2025, Prof. Kim is the Editor-in-Chief of the Korean Social Science Journal - the flagship academic journal of the Korean Social Science Council, KSSC - an association of fifteen national academic associations in social sciences and management studies. Prof. Kim's area of research and teaching covers cinema and television, culture and creative industries, media policy and political economy, and global media. Prof. Kim recently managed a five-year national research project on modelling the Korea's ICT developments and is currently working on the impact of narration in humanity.

After his experience as head of content and business developer of the VOD platform OwnAir.it, Alessandro Masi moved to Los Angeles where he primarily worked in international sales and distribution for companies such as Myriad Pictures, Fremantle US, Cohen Media, Sierra/Affinity, Electric Entertainment, Sony Pictures Entertainment, American Zoetrope, handling successful titles including Barney Thomson, American Gods, The Salesman, Captain Fantastic, Manchester by the Sea, The Librarians, The Family Whistle, Adverse, A Father's Will, Light Falls. International distributor and independent producer with his brand FlexyMovies, always a supporter of innovative film business strategies, has awarded movies with special prizes for their potential on the international markets. He achieved a BSc in business economics from UniSiena, an MSc in media management from Bocconi, an MBA from Hult, a certificate in business of entertainment from UCLA. Born in Belgrade, Dubravka graduated in journalism at the Faculty of Political Sciences, University of Belgrade in 1983, she started her career in 1982 on Radio Belgrade. From 1995 to 1997, she worked in RTV Politika where she was the creator of a film show called "In Media Res", and from 2000 to 2004 another called "Kino-Klub". She is a member of the European Film Academy (EFA), a member of the Executive Board of the Federation of Film Critics of Europe and the Mediterranean (FEDEORA), a member of the International Federation of Film Critics (FIPRESCI), a selector of the international program of the Cinema City IFF in Novi Sad, a member of the Board of the Belgrade documentary film festival Beldocs and a member of the Board of the Serbian Film Center.

Television journalist since 1983 for ARD, ZDF, 3sat, arte. Founded in 1999 the film production "Magic Mountain Film Berlin" with focus on the cultural documentary. Author of numerous documentary films.

Per il River Film Festival, inoltre, il San Gaetano rappresenta già uno spazio carico di valore: qui, nel 2025, ha trovato casa Veneto Agorà Cinema, evento speciale e primo mercato audiovisivo del festival, consolidando un legame importante tra il RiFF e uno dei luoghi simbolo della cultura cittadina.

The Centro Culturale Altinate San Gaetano, located at Via Altinate 71 in the heart of Padua, is one of the city's most significant cultural venues. Its central location and easy accessibility make it an ideal place to host audiences, institutions, and cultural professionals, fostering exchange, participation, and visibility. For the River Film Festival, San Gaetano also represents a space rich in meaning: in 2025, it hosted Veneto Agorà Cinema, a special event and the festival's first audiovisual market, strengthening an important connection between RiFF and one of the city's symbolic cultural landmarks.

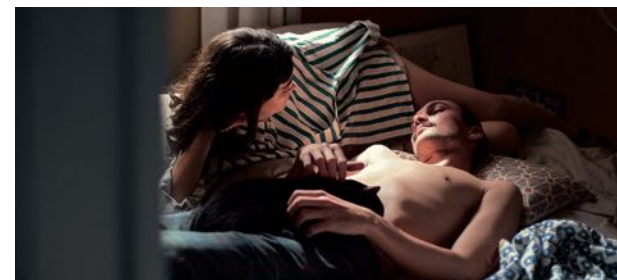

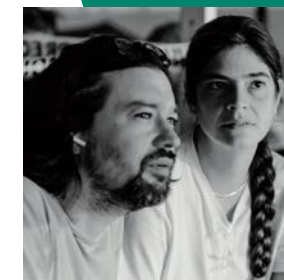

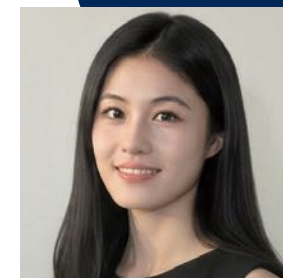
DREAMS OF BLINDNESS

With a background in visual communication and a deep love for culture and symbolism, her work often explores the invisible threads between faith, ritual, and identity. Drawn since childhood to the spiritual side of life, from folk tales and prayers to the quiet rituals that shape everyday existence, Kenzy uses film and photography to listen rather than look.

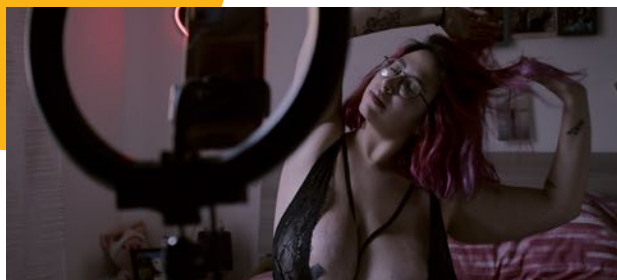

The place is the same, but its meaning has constantly changed. This is not a film about geography or a list of exotic names—it's a first-person story about the time I spent there. A journey far from eurocentrism, where what took me 7,000 km from home wasn't tourism or curiosity, but something else.



Xoan Escudero

Xoan Escudero (Vigo, 1981). Trained as an art historian, Xoan Escudero began his career in film as a sound technician in the early 2000s. His growing interest in visual storytelling led him to direct his first short film, Curta nº2 (2009). In the following years, he focused on screenwriting, he co-founded the production company Y La Nave Va and directed his first music video. In 2017, he released O Tempo Futuro, finalist at the Mestre Mateo Awards. He returned in 2025 with Nur Sultán, a first-person non-fiction short exploring his personal connection to Kazakhstan.

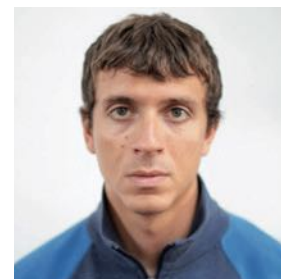

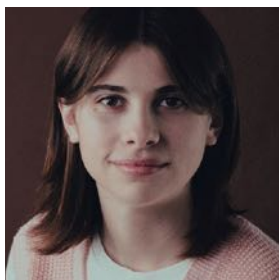

SPARTITI MANCANTI

Nel Settecento Napoli fu uno dei più importanti centri musicali d'Europa. Nei quattro conservatori cittadini nacque il cosiddetto metodo dei partimenti, oggi quasi dimenticato e non più in uso da secoli. Si trattava di un metodo basato sullo scrivere soltanto alcune parti di certi strumenti, tralasciandone altre: si dava infatti per scontato che gli allievi sapessero ricavare le parti mancanti grazie alla tradizione orale e alla loro formazione musicale.

In the 18th century, Naples was one of the most important musical centres in Europe. The four conservatories in the city gave rise to the so-called partimenti method, now almost forgotten and no longer in use for centuries. This method involved writing only some parts for certain instruments, leaving others out: it was assumed that students would be able to figure out the missing parts thanks to oral tradition and their musical training.



Chiara Zoja

Chiara Zoja (born 2004) is an Italian director and writer. She is making her debut with the short doc *Lola*, which in 2024 won second prize in Match and Catch, a ideas competition organized by Film Commission Vallée d'Aoste. Alongside her film studies at DAMS in Turin, she has been training as a director through audiovisual projects between Piedmont and Aosta Valley. At the heart of her storytelling lies the desire to give voice to courageous women's stories, rooted between past and present.



Eleonora Valentino

Eleonora Valentino was born on 30 January 2002 in Cagliari but lives, works and studies in Naples. In 2024, she obtained a bachelor's degree in cinema and audiovisual studies from the Academy of Fine Arts in Naples and is continuing her studies by attending a two-year specialisation course in cinema. 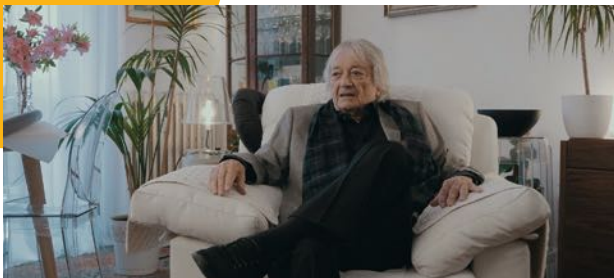
Alexandra Breznay

Glitches, useless gestures, and artificial creatures reveal how anxiety reshapes perception, turning technical errors into part of the emotional texture of the work.



Francesco D'Isa

Francesco D'Isa (Florence, 1980) is a philosopher, visual artist, and writer. He is currently a researcher at the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia, where his work investigates the aesthetic and philosophical impact of AI-generated imagery. He teaches Philosophy at the Istituto Lorenzo de' Medici (Florence) and AI Applied to Art at the LABA Academy of Fine Arts (Brescia and Florence). He has published novels, essays, and graphic novels.

A pioneer in the use of generative AI as an expressive medium, he has made several short films that draw on the visual and expressive languages of the past to interrogate the present. His work has screened at Academy Award-qualifying festivals including Cinequest and Tehran ISFF, won Best Animation Audience Choice at Beverly Hills Film Festival 2025, and received the Honoree Award at Runway AI Film Festival 2024.

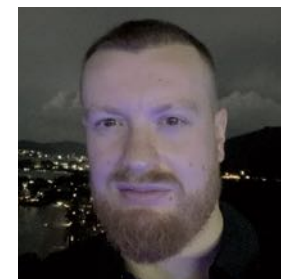

I 17 obiettivi sono stati adottati nel 2015 dalle Nazioni Unite come parte dell'Agenda 2030. Essi pongono l'accento sulle grandi sfide del nostro tempo, come la fame, la povertà e la pace, nonché il consumo di risorse e il cambiamento climatico. La realizzazione di questi obiettivi dipende da tutti: governi, aziende, organizzazioni e individui.

Il River Film Festival sottolinea la particolare responsabilità dell'industria culturale e cinematografica nel raggiungimento di questi obiettivi. L'impegno del festival è evidente negli esempi di sei obiettivi: istruzione di qualità (SDG 4), uguaglianza di genere (SDG 5), energia pulita e accessibile (SDG 7), industria, innovazione, infrastrutture (SDG 9), consumo e produzione sostenibili (SDG 12), azione per il clima (SDG 13).
